country, and/or are registered with the American Volleyball Coaches Association. All coaches are DBS checked or hold their nation's equivalent. Camps are led by coaches who are involved with England, Great Britain or other national development teams and the national squads, who coach National League teams, who have played professionally, or who coach university teams.

Parents should note that additional forms will be required for enrolment in the camps, including a parental release form giving permission to photograph their child during the camp, and providing information about their child's medical history.

Athletes wishing to attend a VbDC Summer Camp may be required to submit additional information before their application can be accepted. These may include videos of the athlete in games or training; a letter of recommendation from their coach providing a brief background on their training and the level of competition in which they have participated; and a hand-written letter from the applicant providing details of the level of volleyball they have played and explaining their plans for future participation in the sport. Students from abroad may need to provide additional documents, such as a certificate of medical insurance coverage, and parental permission for certain forms of travel. Some camps have a residential option, and organizers of the VbDC Summer Camps can help arrange for housing, which will incur an additional cost.
